Dear SCNA Customer:

Please be hereby informed that Acetone, Methyl Ethyl Ketone, and Ethanol SDA 39C containing Diethyl Phthalate, if purchased from Sasol Chemicals North America (SCNA), is prohibited as a condition of sale from use in any pesticide inert application.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency issued test orders to all U.S. manufacturers and importers of Acetone, Methyl Ethyl Ketone and Diethyl Phthalate on 2/4/10 that mandated that if these chemicals are sold for use as a pesticide inert they must be tested by these companies under the EPA's Endocrine Disruptor Screening Program (EPA EDSP). SCNA imports both Acetone and Methyl Ethyl Ketone and is thereby subject to this EPA order.

Since SCNA does not currently sell or ever intend to sell its Acetone or Methyl Ethyl Ketone for use in a pesticide inert application, it has chosen to respond to the EPA order by Opting Out of Any Pesticide Inert Applications. Consequently, it will not be required to participate in the testing program.

To further implement the use restriction, SCNA will amend its sales contract terms and conditions to include the following statement: "Buyer acknowledges that it has been adequately warned by Seller, that Seller's Acetone and Methyl Ethyl Ketone are prohibited from use in any pesticide formulation".
